**● Sea Otter** Here at the Asamushi Aquarium, we feed the sea otters a variety of shellfish, squid, and fish 4-5 times every day. One sea otter eats between 6-8 kilograms (20-30% of their body weight) of food in one day, so preparing their meals takes lots of work.



**● Humboldt Penguin** These charming creatures, who are comfortable around people, are one of the aquarium's most popular attractions.



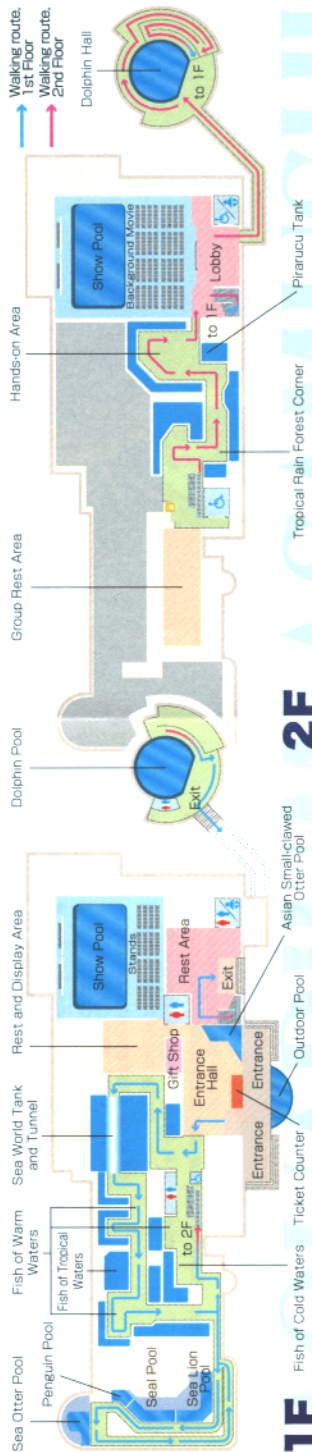
**● Oriental Small-Clawed Otter** These charming creatures, who are comfortable around people, are one of the aquarium's most popular attractions.

**● Tropical Forest Area** The environment of the rivers in South America and South-east Asia are recreated here.



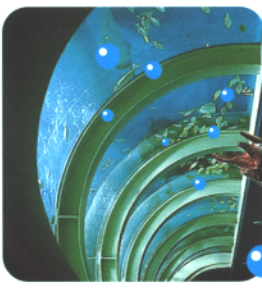

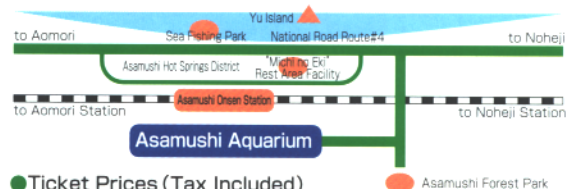
## Asamushi Aquarium's New Hero

### ● Getting to Asamushi Aquarium

- By Plane ▶ Tokyo to Aomori, 1hr. & 10 min. ... From Aomori Airport by taxi, 40 min.
- By Train ▶ Hakodate to Aomori, 2hrs. 2min. by express train ... Aomori to Asamushi Onsen Station, 15 min. Morioka to Asamushi Onsen Station, 2hrs. 2min. 10min. walk from Asamushi Onsen Station
- By Bus ▶ Morioka to Aomori, 2hrs. 45 min. Aomori to Asamushi Onsen, 40 min. by JR or city bus
- By Car ▶ Morioka Interchange to Aomori interchange (168km) Aomori interchange to National Route #4, 45 min.
